Registration: Campers may register in two ways for the camp. Choose the way best for you listed below:

1) Fill out the application below and mail it with a \$50.00, NON-REFUNDABLE deposit, or full payment to: **Adrian Blewitt, P.O. Box 7356, Hickory, NC 28603. Make checks payable to 'Golden Touch Soccer'.**

2) Register and submit payment online with a credit card by going to the Golden Touch Soccer Camps web site (www.goldentouchsoccer.com). Click the 'online application' button in the left hand column, complete the application, then press the 'submit' button. Then, go back to the left column and scroll down to 'online payment'. Click on the 'community camp' button which applies to you. The \$50 NON-REFUNDABLE deposit may be submitted or the full amount.

Discounts: Siblings, \$5 off **each camper** for half-day camp: \$10 off **each camper** for full day camp.

Arrival and Departure: Campers should report to the St. Stephens High School Soccer field around 8:45am. Staff will be there at 8am each morning to accommodate '**early drop off**' campers. Camp will end for half-day campers at 12pm each day. For full day campers, camp will end at 4pm. Staff will be at the field until 5pm to accommodate '**late pick up**' campers. **Camp will end for half and full day campers at 12pm on Friday. College Prep Camp, Mon-Thur.**

What to Bring: Each camper should have a soccer ball for camp. Campers may bring their own soccer ball or, may purchase one from the camp for \$20.00. Campers aged 4-10 years are advised to use a size 4 ball. For ages 11 and over a size 5 is advised. Campers may bring snacks to eat during breaks. Full day campers should bring their own lunch. Lunch will not be provided by the camp. Sun screen, shin guards, outdoor soccer shoes and sneakers are also recommended. Water is provided by the camp.

Staff: Adrian Blewitt, Director of Soccer at Lenoir-Rhyne College, heads the Golden Touch Camp staff. In his three years at LR, Blewitt has taken the men's soccer team from the bottom of the SAC to the top, winning the SAC Tournament Championship in 2006 and finishing with a final national ranking of #5. The bears also broke the school record for the number of wins in a single season (19) which was set in by Blewitt's first season in 2005 (13). The 2006 Men also made the NCAA tournament for the first time in program history, finishing as the #1 seed in the Appalachian Region, the season eventually ending in the 'sweet 16'. Blewitt was named the SAC 'Coach of the Year' and the Appalachian region 'Coach of the Year', as well as being one of 8 candidates for national coach of the year. In December of 2006, Blewitt was named 'Director of Soccer' and accepted the challenge of taking the reigns of the LR Women's program as well as the men's. In his first season coaching the LR Women, Blewitt's ladies more than doubled their number of wins and advanced to the semi-final of the SAC Tournament.

LR assistant coach Tom Gott will direct the goalkeeping academy as well as serve as assistant camp director.

Baby Bears: Ages 4-5, 9am to 10am, Monday to Friday, \$40

The 'Baby Bears' program is designed to introduce our campers to soccer and the fun that can be had by all using a soccer ball in many different ways. At this age, our aim is to familiarize a child with how a soccer ball can be a fun thing to play with, using any and all parts of the body (even the hands) to have a fun experience! This program consists of games, challenges, songs, and even soccer stories, all packed into one hour each morning! The perfect program to get your child's soccer career rolling!!!

College Prep Camp: Ages 15-18, 6pm to 8pm, Monday to Thursday, \$80

Our 'college prep' camp is designed to provide our local, high school aged students the chance to experience college level coaching and training. This program may help them decide if playing at the next level is something they would like to shoot for and if they could be good enough. Advanced development of technical and tactical training will enable the student to find out more about their own soccer attributes and form a realistic view of what it takes to be a college player!
